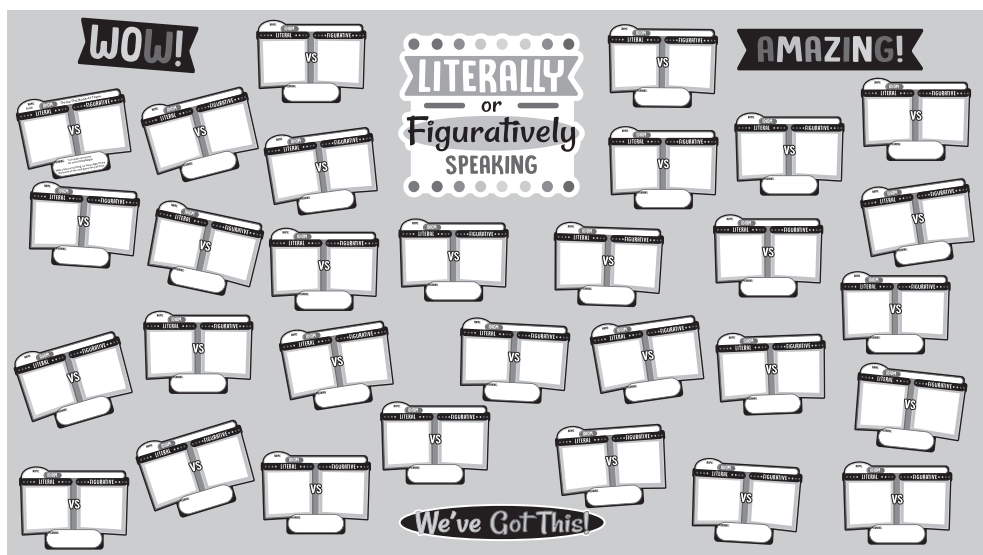


# 13831922 BUILD A BOARD - LITERAL VS. FIGURATIVE RESOURCE GUIDE

Example of assembled bulletin board:



Create a bulletin board with your students' work!  
Assess your students' knowledge and display their work  
with this Literal vs. Figurative Build a Board Activity.

Provide each student with a prompt card. Have each student pick an idiom or provide them with one. Have the students write the idiom of choice at the top. Next, students can draw the literal and the figurative meaning of the idiom. Finally, have students use their idiom in a sentence.

There are 30 prompt cards with the bulletin board.
