

14097177 BIBLE WHICH WOULD YOU RATHER DO? GAME RESOURCE GUIDE

Bible Which Would You Rather Do? Game is a fun and engaging biblical game. Upper elementary students, tweens, teens and adults will all enjoy the game as an icebreaker, time-filler activity, or at family game night.

The basic idea is to present or ask a “Which would you rather do?” question. Included in the game are 36 question cards. Each person has to decide on an answer, but they must include the reason for how they answered the question.

The suggestions below may be used to engage players. Use these suggestions or create a new way to engage players as they think about the people and stories in the Bible.

- Identify the “or” parts of the question as “A” or “B” and two sides of the playing area as “A” and “B.” Ask the question and have the players run to the side of the room that represents their answer. Depending on the size of the group, each side can discuss the question and present the reasons behind their answer.
- With a larger group of players, identify the “or” parts of the question as “A” or “B” and have students answer “A” by standing up or “B” by remaining sat down. Select a few players to present the reasons behind their answers.
- With a small group of players, players can write down their responses and take turns presenting the reasons behind their answers.

These questions will engage players and encourage some great conversations. Be prepared for some excitement and let the players have fun discussing and sharing. This activity can also lead to a discussion on the need to sometimes take a stand, even if the rest of the “crowd” are choosing to do something different.
