

14268632 Phonics Sorting Cards

Students will use the sets of cards to learn the critical literacy skills of rhyming words, onset sounds, and vowel sounds. They will be engaged through this hands-on activity of sorting word sets.

How to use the word sets:

These cards can be used with or without sorting baskets.

1. Students will choose which set of cards they are going to use.
 - Red cards - Rhyming words
 - Green cards - Onset sounds (beginning sound in the word. Remind kids this is not always the same letter)
 - Blue cards - Vowel sound (Remind students this is not always the same letter or letters)
2. Students sort the cards into two piles, or if using them, the baskets, one for "yes or correct" and the other for "no" if it doesn't match.

Cards are color-coded to show which skill is being worked on and mastered.
