


Example of math mats in use:

CARD FRONT ADDITION





CARD BACK SUBTRACTION



Addition (card front):

- 1. Have students work independently or with a partner to spin two numbers and write them in the top boxes.
- 2. Students place the correct number of wiggle eyes on each monster.
- Students write the numbers in the boxes below each monster and total the numbers for the answer.

Subtraction (card back):

- 1. Have students work independently or with a partner to spin two numbers and write them in the top boxes.
- 2. Students write the largest number they spin in the first box. They write the smaller number they spin in the second box.
- 3. Students place the correct number of wiggle eyes from the first box on the first monster.
- 4. Students move the number of wiggle eyes written in the second box to the white box.
- 5. Students look at how many wiggle eyes are left on the monster to find the answer.
- 6. Students write the correct numbers in the boxes below to finish the number sentence.
