

Laughing Man

***Laughing Man* is very durable and easy to set up, but please read these instructions for your safety and for *Laughing Man's* longevity.**

- You will need to lift *Laughing Man's* shirt and carefully cut the wire tie or tape that is around the cords, being careful not to pull too hard on the connections.
- Place *Laughing Man* in a chair with armrests.
- **CAUTION...** Do not restrict the movement of *Laughing Man* in any way. The motor is very durable; however, you can strip the gears if prop cannot move freely.
- **CAUTION...** *Laughing Man's* motor is located in his back – be sure to keep fingers away from spinning metal disc. NOTE: Over time, the spinning metal disc in *Laughing Man's* back may make a small worn spot / or tear in *Laughing Man's* shirt– this is normal. If desired, you may replace *Laughing Man's* shirt with one you purchase.
- Simply place *Laughing Man* near electrical outlet (110 V) and plug into the wall outlet. In a few seconds, *Laughing Man* will begin to shake.
- NOTE: The metal in *Laughing Man* back and base could scratch wood, etc, so don't place in chair that is valuable.
- An Audio CD of *Laughing Man* is enclosed to play with *Laughing Man* if desired. You can put this in a CD Player and place nearby, or you can play it through your home stereo. If playing through home stereo, be sure to place the speakers near *Laughing Man*. Press the **REPEAT 1** button on your CD Player so that *Laughing Man's* soundtrack will loop and he will continue to make sound.
- **NOTE: Run for 2 hours at a time and then let cool before running again.**

TROUBLE SHOOTING

- Make sure *Laughing Man* is placed on a level chair so that he doesn't fall out of the chair as he shakes.
- If *Laughing Man* doesn't operate when plugged in, first check to make sure the electrical outlet has power to it. (i.e. by plugging in a lamp, etc.) If *Laughing Man* still does not shake, UNPLUG from wall outlet, lift *Laughing Man's* shirt and make sure both wires are connected to the motor (**Use the wiring diagram on the motor**). If not, reconnect and plug back in.
