

# Deadly Doll

**DU 2632**

***Deadly Doll* is very durable and easy to set up, but please read these instructions for your safety and for *Deadly Doll's* longevity.**

- You will need to find a chair to set *Deadly Doll* in. **CAUTION** ... *Deadly Doll* is 'built to last' so metal is used in her construction. If *Deadly Doll* is to be placed in an important chair, care should be taken to protect the chair. You can secure a small blanket or foam pad onto the chair before putting *Deadly Doll* on.
- **CAUTION**...Do not restrict the movement of *Deadly Doll* in any way (i.e. tying her body to the chair with ropes, etc.). The motor is very durable; however, you can strip the gears if prop cannot move freely.
- **CAUTION**...The motor used to move *Deadly Doll* has been enclosed in metal to help prevent injury. However, care should be taken to keep people away from the chair and to keep hands away from the metal box that the motor is in as fingers may be injured by the motor.
- Remove the enclosed Power Supply and attach the included power cord.
- Simply place *Deadly Doll* and chair near electrical outlet (110 V). **FIRST**, plug the power supply into the motor's cord and **THEN** plug the power supply into the wall outlet. In a few seconds, *Deadly Doll* will begin to rock.
- An Audio CD of *Deadly Doll* talking is enclosed to play with *Deadly Doll* if desired. You can put this in a CD Player and place near the chair, or you can play it through your home stereo. If playing through home stereo, be sure to place the speakers near *Deadly Doll*. **NOTE**...you will need to select the track you want, then press the **REPEAT 1** button on your CD Player so that *Deadly Doll's* soundtrack will loop and she will continue to talk

## TROUBLE SHOOTING

- If *Deadly Doll* doesn't operate when plugged in, first check to make sure the electrical outlet has power to it (i.e. by plugging in a lamp, etc.)
- You can also check the wires leading into the motor from the Power Supply...they sometimes can get dislodged. Since there are several posts that the wires slide onto, you may need to try several variations until you get the correct attachments. Make sure the correct attachments are made so that *Deadly Doll* doesn't rock too fast.
